#### HAZEL CLASS BRAESIDE KIT LIST 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020

A small wheeled suitcase is most desirable as pupils are dropped off at the gate. A rucksack for daytime use is **also required**. Please make sure all luggage, along with all other belongings, is clearly labelled with your child's name and the name of the school.

The children should not bring with them any new or expensive clothing – old, casual, warm and easily washable clothes are strongly recommended. **Jeans are not practical** as they provide no warmth when wet and are difficult to dry. Clothes and shoes may get very dirty.

#### **Kit List:**

sun cream	toiletries – flannel, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste,
sun hat	shampoo, hairbrush/comb
warm jumpers	plastic water bottle (refillable)
waterproof coat	plastic lunch box (2 litres ice cream type is fine)
3 pairs socks and underwear	plastic carrier bags for bringing home wet clothing
night clothes and teddy	a book
towel	slippers/trainers for indoors
2 pairs trousers/joggers	2 T-shirts
small rucksack/backpack	comfortable walking shoes
warm hat and gloves	wellies
old trainers (that will stay on your feet) for canoeing (these will get wet)	

Pocket money (we suggest £5, in £1 coins, in a labelled purse inside their bag).

*No sweets or snacks please.*

Any medicines/inhalers should be clearly labelled and handed to staff on Wednesday morning with instructions. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please administer one dose before school and send another in a named, sealed envelope/container for the return journey with instructions for when the tablet should be taken in relation to the time of the journey.
