What a busy year we have had at FoNS, working hard to resume normal fundraising efforts. We would like to thank you all for your ongoing support, we are already looking forward to organising some more great events from September.

This year, FoNS have been able to give school £2000 towards enhancing our children's school experience. Successful events like the **fRUNdraiser**, **Easter Trail**, school **tea-towels**, **Christmas cards**, **Juke Box Mash-Up** and providing marshals for the **Corsham 10 km** have all helped us to raise this amount of money. The school will put this money towards The Learning Resources Hub subscription; this provides invaluable, high quality and accessible resources to support and extend the learning in every classroom. Sadly, for the first time in FoNS' existence, we have not been able to give the school the total sum of money needed for this subscription. A timely reminder that we need to get back to some of our pre-COVID events soon, and we look forward to your support with this.

The school grounds have benefited from the return of **Groundforce Day**, when over 70 members of the school community worked hard digging, weeding, planting and clearing. FoNS is not just about raising money; days like Groundforce Day are equally important.
