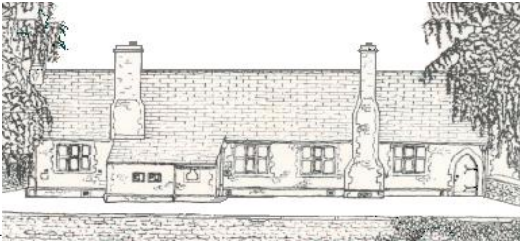

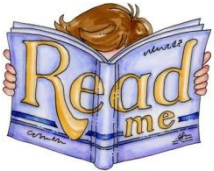

Young wizards and their parents will be able to enjoy a bite to eat in The Leaky Cauldron and browse in Flourish and Blotts (aka The Corsham Bookshop!) where all manner of books suitable for young wizards will be available. Children are invited to come in the appropriate Hogwarts uniform if they wish. This event will run from **5.00pm to 6.30pm**.

We are very excited about this event and know that many of the children are too, but, having carried out the required risk assessment we unfortunately have to limit attendance, thereby ensuring that we are able to run a fun but, above all, safe event. We would ask, therefore, that if your child/children would like to attend the Harry Potter event that you complete the reply slip below and return it to the class teacher by **Tuesday 28th February**. If we receive more replies than we have places, we will put all reply slips into the Sorting Hat and will randomly pick out names until all the places are filled. We will inform you, as soon as possible by Owl, if your child/children have a place. We are sorry but we will not be able to consider any replies received after Tuesday.

Please note, if you have more than one child at school who wishes to attend, then you should only use **one** reply slip. Also, we are sorry, but pre-school age children are *not* able to attend the Harry Potter Night. Parents will need to be on site for the duration of the event. While your child/children are enjoying the activities you will be able to relax at The Leaky Cauldron, browse in Flourish and Blotts or spend time in the Hogwarts' Common Rooms!

We will have some of the Harry Potter activities available at our Books and Bacon event on Thursday 9th March at 8.00am and all children and parents are invited to this very popular event (please see separate letter coming soon!).
