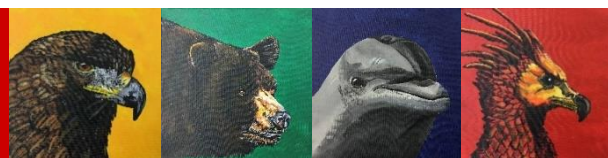

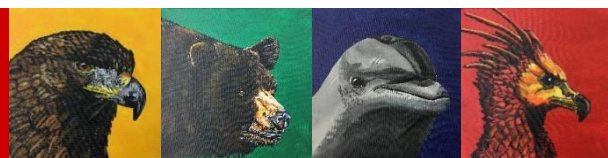

Being in school at least 95% of the time or 180 to 190 days



Percentage attendance	What this means for your child
98%	Excellent attendance that will contribute towards excellent learning and progress.
96-97%	Good attendance that will contribute towards good learning and progress.
93-95%	Average attendance & monitored closely
80-92%	Below average attendance that may begin to have an adverse effect on learning and progress. The school will closely monitor the absences and reasons for them. The Educational Welfare Officer may become involved and a school attendance meeting may take place.
Less than 80%	Very poor attendance that will have a negative effect on learning and progress. The Educational Welfare Officer will become involved in supporting the family to improve attendance.



School Dinners



Please can we remind you that meals need to be ordered at least one week in advance.

The **booking deadline is midnight on a Wednesday** and a text is sent out at 6pm on Wednesday every week.

If you miss the midnight deadline, ParentPay will not allow you to book meals for the following week. You will still be able to order for subsequent weeks, with the option to book for the whole term, if you wish.

If you do miss the booking deadline, you will need to provide a home packed lunch for the whole of the following week.

Our kitchen orders the food and prepares the meals based on the number of dinners booked on a Wednesday. This helps to reduce food wastage and keeps costs down, which is especially important with the current economic climate.

Dear Parents / Carers

Neston Primary School - Potential Option to Join a Multi-Academy Trust

The Governing Board has been watching for several years the development of Multi-Academy Trusts (MATs). A MAT is an education charity that has responsibility for running and maintaining a group of schools. The current Government's intention is that schools should move into MATs and this seems very unlikely to change with any change in government. Many of the primary schools local to Neston are already part of a MAT and we are noticing a reduction in levels of support from the Local Authority. As a result, we are feeling that to do nothing is no longer acceptable.

Our aim at all times is to protect the ethos and values of Neston school (which we have recently refreshed and shared with you) and to ensure any future arrangement is aspirational for our children and values our school community. We have explored many MATs and have recently identified a potential opportunity to shape and join a newly forming MAT. The new MAT is to be called Mosaic, will be for primary schools only across part of both South Glos. and Wiltshire. We believe that it will be consistent with our ethos, vision and values and focused on ongoing school improvement.

We have started a period of due diligence and the Governing Board must decide by 17 July whether to progress this potential option to explore joining further. If we do choose to explore further, the next step will be to consult with the school community later in the autumn. If you have any questions in the meantime, please email admin@neston.wilts.sch.uk

We are excited by this potential opportunity and the option it gives for our school to continue to develop and ensure that, as our vision states, "our children learn well as part of a strong, creative community which cares deeply and dares greatly".

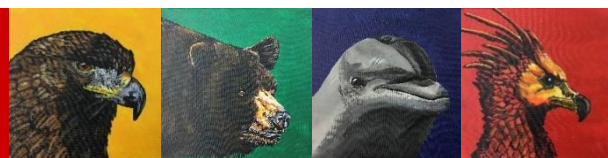

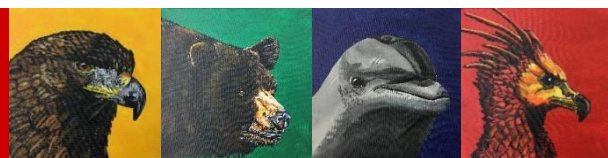

Our courses are designed to enable adults to build confidence, gain new skills, reconnect with learning and take their next steps to further learning, volunteering or employment

- Family skills - helping your child with learning and emotional wellbeing
- Independent living skills for adults with learning difficulties and disabilities.

- military family
- family with SEN child
- are unemployed and seeking employment

*Adults with certain types of immigration status and their family members are also eligible to join our courses.

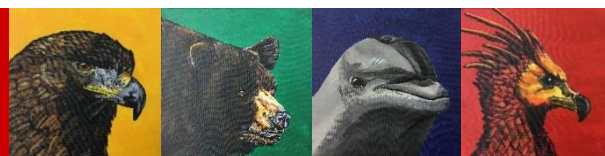

Children should not have medicine in their school bags and self-administer. This can include creams, calpol, ibuprofen, hayfever tablets etc.

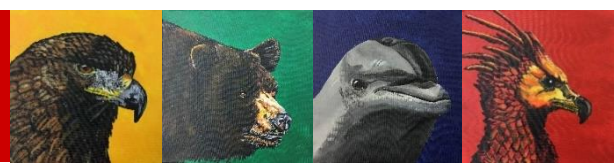

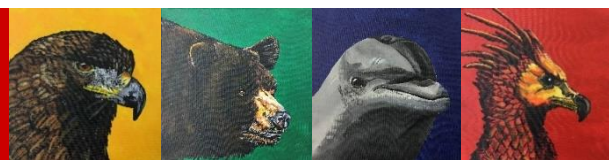

We thank you for your continued support in this matter.



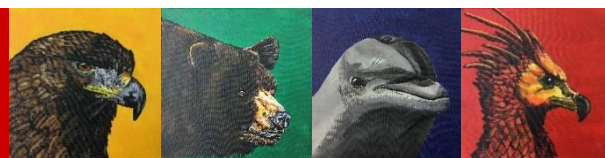
